- 4. Providing your identification card and a duly signed examination card
- 5. Not carrying books, bags, notes, rough papers and any other paraphernalia in to examination rooms.
- 6. Allowing invigilator to confiscate any unauthorized materials and expel you from the examination room if you create disturbance.
- 7. Not entering the examination room with a phone(s), headphones, earphones etc.

- 10. Not using auto coding software such as Chatgpt during exams.
